- A.) **IV. ACTION ITEMS.**

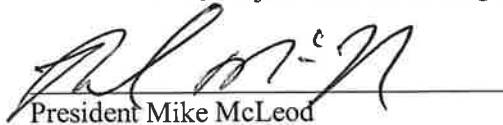

Motion carried 5-0.
